ORDER

(Date: 29th October, 2025)

1. This appeal is filed under Sec. 10 of Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavasayik Shikshan Sanstha (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk ka Nirdharan), Adhiniyam, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as “Act of 2007”) against the order passed by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC for short) dated 23/07/2025, whereby the fee for the appellant institute was fixed at Rs. 79,200/- per student per year for B.H.M.S. course being run by it, for academic sessions 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the appellant that calculation of fees has not been properly done and in this fee, it is difficult to meet expenditure of the college. The appellant further submitted that after implementation of new revised MSR-2024, issued by National Commission of Homoeopathy, the expenditure would increase and the fee regulated by the AFRC is on lower side.

3. On the other hand, however, respondent supported the impugned order on the ground that the Chartered Accountant of AFRC calculated the fee of the institution on the basis of the audited financial data and according to its calculation the fee comes to Rs. 45,000/- per student per year. However, the committee decided to increase the fee of the institution by previous fee regulated by it.
4. I have heard both the parties. Perused the record.
5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the documents filed by the appellant before the respondent, it appears that the fee regulated by the AFRC is proper. The AFRC has not committed any error to regulating fee of the appellant institution. Therefore, appeal is liable to be dismissed and dismissed accordingly.

This appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
