ORDER

(Date: 11th November, 2025)

1. This appeal is filed under Sec. 10 of Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavasayik Shikshan Sanstha (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk ka Nirdharan), Adhiniyam, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as “Act of 2007”) against the order passed by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC for short) dated 25/08/2025, whereby the fee for the appellant institute was fixed at Rs. 25,700/- per student per semester for B.Pharm. course being run by it, for academic sessions 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the appellant the fee of the appellant college is on lower side. It is further submitted that income and expenditure of the college has not been considered by the AFRC properly. Therefore, the fees as regulated by AFRC may be increased by this Authority.

3. On the other hand, it is submitted on behalf of the respondent that after considering audited balance sheet of the college, proper fee has been regulated by AFRC. Therefore, impugned order is not interferable.
4. I have heard both the parties. Perused the record.
5. The Chartered Accountant of the respondent calculated entire expenditure of the institution before this Authority and it was found that the AFRC has considered entire expenditure of the institution properly and fairly calculated the fee of the course. No error has been committed by AFRC in passing of the impugned order.
6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, it is apparent that the fee regulated by the AFRC is proper. The AFRC has not committed any error to regulating fee of the appellant institution. Therefore, appeal is liable to be dismissed and dismissed accordingly.

This appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
