ORDER

(Date: 27th November, 2025)

1. This appeal is filed under Sec. 10 of Madhya Pradesh Niji Vyavasayik Shikshan Sanstha (Pravesh Ka Viniyaman Avam Shulk ka Nirdharan), Adhiniyam, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as “Act of 2007”) against the order passed by the Admission and Fee Regulatory Committee (AFRC for short) dated 19/08/2025, whereby the fee for the appellant institute was regulated at Rs. 17,000/- per student per semester for Diploma Pharmacy (2 Year) course being run by it, for academic session 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28.
2. It is submitted on behalf of the appellant that all expenditure of the course has not been considered by the AFRC, he further submitted that the appellant had uploaded all relevant audited balance sheets, but the documents has not been considered properly. Therefore, the impugned order deserves to be set aside and appeal should be allowed.
3. On the other hand, it is submitted by the Chartered Accountant of AFRC that on the basis of audited balance sheet for F.Y. 2024-25 filed by the appellant in this appeal and she also calculated average expenditure between F.Y. 2022-23 to 2024-25. She explained on the basis of calculation, the fee comes at Rs. 36,000/- per student per year. The respondent further submits that he has no objection, if the fee is enhanced from Rs. 34,000/- per student per

year to Rs. 36,000/- per student per year, as per report filed by its Chartered Accountant.

4. I have heard both the parties. Perused the record.
5. After considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances and submission of the parties, as the Chartered Accountant of AFRC has calculated the fee ₹ 36,000/- per student per semester. Therefore, in view of this Authority, fee regulated by AFRC for academic sessions 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28 for Diploma Pharmacy (2 Years) course is enhanced from ₹ 17,000/- per student per semester to ₹ 18,000/-per student per semester or ₹ 36,000/- per student per year. Other charges fixed by AFRC shall remain same.

This appeal stands disposed of accordingly.
